

Rory Mor's Horn

One of the prize possessions of the Clan MacLeod is Sir Rory Mor's Horn. It is kept at Dunvegan Castle on the Isle of Skye, Scotland.

Sir Rory Mor's Horn is a drinking horn, made of an ox's horn, tipped in silver. The rim around the mouth of the horn is thick and bears seven imprinted medallions. Three of the medallions depict beasts, three depict patterns, and the seventh and joining medallion shows both a pattern and a beast. R. C. MacLeod considered the work to be Norse, and declared the horn to date from the 10th century.
